Brownstein Hyatt Farber Schreck Hosted Cocktails & Conversation to benefit Dress for Success Southern Nevada, April 28

LAS VEGAS - Brownstein Hyatt Farber Schreck, a law firm making a positive impact in the local community, hosted Cocktails & Conversation on Thursday, April 28 inside the Molasky Corporate Center. The event supported Dress for Success Southern Nevada, a nonprofit that empowers women to achieve economic independence by providing a network of support, professional clothing, and career development tools.

For several weeks in March and April, Brownstein's Las Vegas office led a suit drive to benefit Dress for Success Southern Nevada. Guests enjoyed cocktails and light bites, as they mixed and mingled with like-minded professionals and learned more about Dress for Success Southern Nevada.

Dress for Success provides women with an interview outfit to help boost their confidence and make a great first impression. The donation drive and evening event were part of Brownstein's Karma program, which provides employees—along with their friends, families and clients—an opportunity to volunteer and connect with causes in the community.
